By participating in our We Save program, you can save energy and earn rebates when you install a Vending Machine Controller on your indoor refrigerated vending machine.

What rebate can I earn?

Vending Machine Controller **\$50**

How much energy can I save?

By installing a Vending Machine Controller you can achieve energy savings as high as 45%. In low-traffic areas such as K-12 schools and office buildings that are occupied 5-6 days a week, you could save over 55%.

How Do I Qualify?

- Non-residential customers receiving electric service from a local municipal electric utility that is a participating member of MMPA are eligible for the Vending Machine Controller rebate.
- **Vending Machine Controller must be installed on an indoor, refrigerated vending machine that contains non-perishable goods and is not located in an area that is occupied 24 hours, 7 days a week.** If you have questions, please call your local municipal electric utility.
- Rebate will be issued in the form of a check, not a utility bill credit. Please allow 6-8 weeks for the rebate check to arrive.
- Your local municipal electric utility reserves the right to inspect installations before issuing the rebate and to perform a random verification audit of your project. If MMPA finds that the application does not comply with MMPA rules and qualifications, any rebate amount may be adjusted.
- Utility does not guarantee that the implementation of energy-efficient measures or use of purchased and installed equipment associated with this program will result in energy or cost savings. The promotion of this rebate program is not an endorsement of any particular vendor, manufacturer, or product, nor is it an implication that unlisted vendors or products are deficient or defective.
- Customers must apply for rebate within one year of purchasing equipment. The purchase date is the date shown on the customer's invoice. Invoice must accompany rebate application.
- Rebate requests are processed on a "first-come first-serve" basis. Annual rebate funds are limited. Rebate programs, qualifications, and amounts are subject to change at any time. The customer is responsible for checking with your local municipal electric utility to determine whether the program is still in effect.
- Qualifying customers must apply for 2011 rebates by November 30, 2011.
